

SAFETY AND ETIQUETTE

Travel single file - Stay to the right, pass on the left.
Give audible warning before passing - If you don't have a bell, give a verbal warning you are approaching.

Do not block the trail - Take breaks to the side.

Be aware and cautious of wildlife.

Take belongings with you and properly dispose of trash in receptacles.

Wear a helmet - According to the Bicycle Safety Institute, helmet use reduces head injury risks by an estimated 85%.

Slow down - Bikers should ride at a safe pace and be cautious of walkers and horses. Please obey the 15MPH signs posted along the trails.

Horses always have the right-of-way, where permitted.

Stay on park property - Don't stray from the trails. Not only is there greater risk of getting lost, but you may be trespassing on private property.

Pets must be leashed and all waste must be picked up - Take advantage of pet stations along the trails. They are take one-leave one systems. Insert clean bags, without holes and tears, one-at-a-time in the top of the receptacle. Retrieve by pulling from the bottom.

On road, bikers ride **with** traffic, while pedestrians walk/run **against** traffic. Always use caution and obey traffic regulations.

- Wear comfortable and sturdy shoes
- Bring drinking water
- Wear bug/mosquito repellent
- Wear sunscreen
- Carry a small first-aid kit
- Bring a mobile phone [store the ranger number in your phone 330.353.2377]
- Leave valuables at home and secure property by locking cars

CONGRESSMAN RALPH REGULA TOWPATH TRAIL PARK - 26.4 MI



This park encompasses 26.4 miles of the 110-mile Ohio and Erie National Heritage Canalway which extends north to Cleveland and south to New Philadelphia. The trail and bordering parklands follow the historic route of the Ohio & Erie Canal. Trailheads are near Rt. 21. The trail is complete from Tuscarawas County into Cuyahoga County! (Trailheads below south to north.)
