BASIC TRAIL PREPARATION

- Wear comfortable and sturdy shoes
- **Bring drinking water**
- Wear bug/mosquito repellent
- Wear sunscreen
- Leave valuables at home and secure property by locking cars



Travel single file - Stay to the right, pass on the left. Take breaks to the side.



(a) Give audible warning before passing - If you don't have a bell, give a verbal warning you are approaching.



Take belongings with you and properly dispose of trash in receptacles.

Wear a helmet - According to the Bicycle Safety Institute, helmet use reduces head injury risks by an estimated 85%. On road, bikers ride with traffic,



Slow down - Bikers should ride at a safe pace and be cautious of walkers and horses. Horses always have the right-of-way, where permitted. Please obey the speed limit signs posted along the trails.

while pedestrians walk/run against traffic. Always

use caution and obey traffic regulations.



Stay on park property - Don't stray from the trails. Not only is there greater risk of getting lost, but you may be trespassing on private property.



Pets must be leashed and all waste must be picked wp Take advantage of pet stations along the trails. Insert clean bags, without holes and tears, one-at-atime in the top of the receptacle. Retrieve by pulling from the bottom.



Hunting at Stark Parks - Hunters must maintain no less than 50 yards of clearance from any building, road, picnic area, official trail or developed area to assure a safe distance from park users. We always encourage wearing bright colors to stand out in nature, and hunters are required to wear orange attire for visibility. For conflicts between visitors or landowners, or to report unauthorized activities, contact Stark Parks Rangers.




